MINER'S TUNE never far back, challenged for the lead on the final turn, responded to pressure while drawing clear then gradually widened while being kept busy. MOLLY MOLLY MOLLY saved ground early and three wide into the far turn, finished steadily while clear for the place. DESERT WITCH trailed early and three wide turning for home, offered a late gain while earning the show award at the wire. BEACH BADGE set the pace inside and weakened in the drive. PEDROIA inside entering the far turn, raced off the rail into the lane and lacked the needed rally. SWEETPRINCESSCHARM well placed while saving ground, lacked a bid then tired in the drive. DREAMING OF ROSE tracked early, was between rivals entering the far turn, moved in in upper stretch and tired.
