LE BERNARDIN chased outside from the start, bid three wide on the far turn, gained a short lead turning for home, inched away while lugging in and prevailed under a drive. EASTER GIFT was bumped after the start, raced off the pace, began to move up entering the far turn, angled out for the drive and closed well outside. GOOD MORNING DIVA tracked inside, came through on the rail to challenge on the far turn and dug in gamely inside through the stretch. INNOCENT MAN set the pace on the inside, dueled between rivals on the far turn and weakened. MIDNIGHT SERENADE did not factor. SPEEDING AGAIN was bumped after the start, raced four wide early, chased and faded. UNBRIDLED'S WAY raced off the pace, was pulled up in the stretch and vanned off.
