ANDYSUN well placed early outside, lodged a four wide bid on the final turn, dueled for command through the lane and proved best. REPENTER set the pace near the rail, was in the three path entering the stretch and continued on gamely to the end. MAGICAL MYTH up close inside, chased on the final turn and weakened in the drive. UNDERSTATEMENT tracked early just off the inside, chased on the final bend and tired through the lane. MARCHING TUNE raced off the rail into the far turn and lacked a rally. SIR TAYPOT trailed and was pulled up entering the far turn then vanned off.
