BAD DEBT up close early inside, raced just off the rail on the final turn, eased out for the drive, responded to urging and drew clear while drifting out some. KNACK raced four wide into the far turn and pressed the issue then finished willingly while no match late to the top one. SKY PIE set the pace inside, battled on the final turn then weakened late. ILLYA KURYAKIN saved ground on the final turn, stayed inside for the drive and needed more. HARLAN RUSH trailed to the lane then gained some late while not a serious threat. DBL NVISABL GEORGE never far back from the outside, lacked the needed rally. WOODRUNNER up close early, raced three wide and between rivals into the far turn, moved closer then weakened in the drive. BARELY NOTHING prompted the early issue, raced in the two path and between foes on the final turn and chased then tired in the drive.
