SOLD THE FARM raced close up between rivals, saved ground on the far turn, bid between foes and drew clear under urging. KNOCKOUT stumbled after the break, raced three wide early, settled off the pace, moved up in the two path on the far turn and rallied for second. ROARS MORE settled off the rail, made a four wide run on the far turn and finished well outside. DOODLEMAN cleared off to set the pace and weakened in the final furlong. KEY TO THE EMPIRE saved ground, raced between rivals turning for home and rallied mildly inside. FINANCIER was outrun early and raced inside in the stretch. CALL ME SWEETHEART raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. BORREGO'S BOY chased inside and failed to respond. ONEINTHEDARK threw the rider in the post parade, raced greenly and did not factor. CONCORDE COUNTY pressed the pace and faded. INDIAN APPEAL chased three wide and gave way on the far turn.
