Footnotes

MY JEFF'S MOMBO alternated for the early lead from outside, battled heads apart outside RED WEASEL into deep stretch and wore down that one in the final twenty yards. RED WEASEL moved up along the rail to contest the pace nearing the far turn, surged to the front leaving the backstretch, came out slightly while maintaining a slim lead entering the stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. POWER BY FAR settled just behind the early leaders after bobbling at the start, moved between horses while launching a bid on the turn then finished willingly to gain a share. SUNNY SIDE raced within striking distance while three wide along the backstretch, fell back slightly on the turn, advanced four wide into the stretch and closed late in the middle of the track. WHAT A GREAT DAY dueled early along the inside, fell back on the far turn and steadily tired thereafter. KEYWEST (CHI) was never a factor.
