Footnotes

ELEVEN NORTH assumed command early, was hooked by SALT IT at the end of the far turn, turn that rival away and held on gamely. SALT IT chased the pacesetter while four wide on the backstretch, made a bid for the lead while three wide, hooked ELEVEN NORTH at the quarter pole, could not stay with her but was clearly second best. POCHO'S DREAM GIRL chased early while four to five wide, took dead aim on the winner at the quarter pole and held third. TOOKIN DOWN was hard to handle early and rank into the clubhouse turn, settled down to chased while two wide on the backstretch, found is best stride on the turn, ran evenly late. FREEDOM'S DAWN was outrun early while off the rail, and was one paced late while in the middle of the racetrack. JANLURAY stalked early while two wide, was urged to keep up with the leaders on the turn and made no impact. EXQUISITE AFFAIR attended to the pace early and stopped horribly.
