DAX raced off the pace on the rail, angled out at the top of the lane, split rivals, closed willingly and prevailed late. BREAK THE GLASS stalked outside, bid between rivals on the far turn and battled it out gamely with the winner to the finish. I'M FEELIN' FINE raced three wide early, bid three wide on the far turn and finished well outside. DR. KENNEY saved ground, made a strong middle move on the rail, dueled inside on the far turn and stayed on well to the end. ALAJMAL settled off the rail, came three wide into the lane and rallied mildly outside. DEAR JOHN bobbled at the break, pulled hard in the early stages, was steadied sharply on the clubhouse turn, settled off the pace, was steadied again entering the far turn, dropped back and finished evenly. JAMZDEANFNKLSTEEN chased inside and tired. OUR NINO set the pace and gave way.
