TWISTED HEART rated on the early lead, saved ground and responded when headed then weakened late. MAX HAZARD always a factor, lacked the needed stretch response. ENERGY CRUNCH failed to menace while four wide. PERILOUS STORM raced outside turning for home and lacked a stretch bid. JERSEY A.J. three wide into the clubhouse turn, lacked a bid. WIDE OPEN ROAD raced in tight between rivals passing the half mile pole and lacked a rally. THIS CAT SWINGS moved out some in the vicinity of the half mile pole, was between foes into the far turn and lacked a rally. SERIOUS BUSINESS saved ground and lacked a bid.
