CHAIRMAN TUCKER hesitated at the start, moved up and was along the inside entering the turn, reached the front nearing the quarter pole then drew off through the lane. GLACIER BAY vied early, raced three wide and between rivals turning for home and earned the place. MAGIC MAX saved ground and lacked the needed late response. CONFIDENCE CRISIS up close early, raced near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed bid. CHASING TED reached the front nearing the half mile pole, vied for the lead just off the inside and weakened in the drive. FORWARD OBSERVER stayed outside and raced four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. ONE ROLL lodged a four wide bid nearing the quarter pole and tired through the lane. VEECU broke a bit slowly then lacked a rally.
