EFFICIENT FRONTIER was rated just off the pace, came from between horses on the far turn, took the lead four wide leaving the eighth pole then finished with a confident hand ride. ALL SPADES angled to the rail and raced unhurriedly to the top of the stretch, was taken out for the drive and rallied for place. QUIDNASKRA was rated close to the pace, made a bid to the outside of the pacesetter in the stretch and was running evenly late. ANOTHER BETTY raced just off the pace near the rail, lacked room through the upper stretch, was taken off the rail near the eighth pole and finished well. ISLAND ECHO was rated clear, caught in midstretch then weakened toward the inside. SEASIDE DELI stalked the early pace then faded on the outside of the far turn.
