### Footnotes

PRECURSOR stumbled at the start, moved to the front along the inside on the backstretch, showed the way to the lane and responded to urging while edging clear. TOBY THE COAL MAN bothered slightly at the start, saved ground to the lane, eased off the inside and advanced into midstretch then finished gamely for the place. EAST END TAP close up early while three wide, was asked for run on the final turn and finished willingly while just missing the place. ABOVE SPIRIT trailed and three wide turning for home, lacked the needed rally. RAPID REDUX set the early pace, raced just off the rail and pressed the issue on the final turn then weakened in the drive. JERSEY TOWN broke out, raced between rivals into the far turn and lacked the needed response.
