AT THE DISCO tracked early three wide, moved to the front nearing the quarter pole and responded to urging while drawing off. LUNA PARK saved ground early, raced four wide into the stretch and earned the place. FLIRTATIOUS SMILE set the early pace, saved ground and was outfinished for the place. FAGEDABOUDIT SAL pulled briefly on the clubhouse turn, raced close up and near the inside into the far turn and lacked the needed response. TIMELESS CLASSIC between rivals into the far turn, raced five wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. HERMOSILLO prompted the early issue, moved to the front briefly between calls on the final turn and tired through the lane. CUBA trailed and five wide into the clubhouse turn, raced out in the strip and lacked a response then was hung wide turning for home. FRANK THE BARBER outside rivals into the far turn, lacked a bid then went wide turning for home.
