DADDY'S HONOR set the pace inside, battled through the lane and won a head bobbing decision. COCO ECOLO always a factor, challenged for the lead turning for home, raced head and head through the stretch then just missed. DEVILISH SILVER raced between rivals heading into the far turn and lacked the needed rally. STOOPENDOUS DIVA stumbled at the start, raced just off the rail on the final turn and chased then tired in the drive. MINESAVE well placed and in the three path leaving the backstretch, tired through the lane. CARRIETTA stayed outside and lacked a rally. NUFFSAID NUFFSAID broke open her stall gate, moved four wide on the final turn and lacked a stretch response. MS GLORY BE in tight early between rivals, saved ground and lacked a bid.
