Footnotes

Gaelic Bay was badly outrun early, found her best stride at the quarter pole while four wide, dove to the inside and just got up in the final strides. Heckuva Time dueled along the rail, lost some ground while still keep the leader in her sights on the turn, had dead aim on the pacesetter at the quarter pole, drifted out a bit in mid stretch, re rallied and just missed.. She's So Unusual tracked while three deep early, took a narrow lead midway around the final turn, opened up a clear lead at the quarter and got very tired in the latter stages of the race. Timely Affair chased early while three wide, was in hand while tracking three wide on the turn, was under an all out drive at the quarter while five wide and was a non threatening fourth. Stylish Approach vied for command early while two wide, dueled along the turn, lost command on the turn, swung out four wide at the quarter pole and tired. Red Riccio tracked while in the first flight of horses three wide, raced two wide on the turn, and passed tired foes. Mary Lou's Magic lunged at the start, laid off the leaders while five wide early, loomed boldly while four wide on the final turn, entered the stretch seven wide and tired. Wedgfield chased the leaders throughout and made little impact.
