ALEX'S PAL always a factor, reached STEVIE BUBBLES leaving the furlong grounds then bested that one while lugging in some. STEVIE BUBBLES vied for the early lead, drew clear on the turn and responded well in the drive but could not resist the top one. WINNING INTENTIONS raced off the rail on the turn and offered a mild late gain from the outside. WISE FOOL well placed while saving ground, weakened in the drive. NEW YORK MINUTE vied for the early lead, raced in the two path on the turn and tired. SPIDER SPIDER veered out sharply at the start dropping well back, improved position into the turn, continued very wide while getting out and tired. DIVE FOR GOLD lacked a response. A SLEW OF EAGLES forwardly placed early, had little left entering the stretch. TOWER'S BEST broke slowly then failed to menace.
