FLIT ABOUT was rated off the pace near the rail, rallied while eased out through the stretch, drew to the leader nearing the wire then won the bob. REMEDIATE raced just off the pace, came around horses at the quarter pole, rallied to the lead leaving midstretch, was briefly clear then lost the bob. HUNTING JADE advanced to the lead rating the pace, was challenged from the top of the stretch, dueled to the eighth pole then weakened. MADAME MODJESKA stalked the pace from the rail the chased the leaders through the stretch. TORROPY raced unhurriedly early, spiraled to the outside of the far turn then rallied widest and was closing well late. BECKY'S RANSOM was rated close on the inside, came off the rail near the quarter pole, was in tight in the upper stretch then came up empty. GOTTA BE A STAR was rated off the pace then weakened. CUSHINA raced unhurriedly then offered no rally. FIFTH AVENUE DOLL raced unhurriedly then was steadied into the far turn. TWILIGHTS PRAYER was rated close to the pace two deep, dropped back near the quarter pole then gave way through the stretch.
