Footnotes

BITTERROOT RIVER, unhurriedly off the rail, started her advance nearing the final turn, angled five wide approaching the quarter pole, achieved gradual momentum through the stretch, matched strides with the runner up late then inched ahead. SMART N CLASSY rated off the pace about the four path, dueled from the top of the stretch, reached a short lead leaving the eighth pole but was outfinished under the wire. KRASNAYA rated off the pace and off the rail, was steadied behind horses entering the stretch, recovered momentum late and finished well. HONORABLE CAT rated close toward the outside early, came through the three path on the final turn, dueled to a short lead in the upper stretch then yielded from the seventy yard pole. EARTHQUAKE RIDE, unhurried outside, bid into the final turn but leveled out late. POUR IT ON never factored. LENTIL broke inward bobbling at the start, rated a short lead in the three path, edged clear nearing the final turn then faded quickly inside entering the stretch. BOMBAY BLUES rated with the early pace off the rail then faded through the final turn. PROVEN FORM bobbed at the break and was through early.
