Footnotes

D'LUCCI GIRL trailed early, advanced between rivals passing the quarter pole and finished gamely while prevailing at the wire. TRINI DUBAI hung six wide into the clubhouse turn then angled inward, tracked from the four path into the far turn, drifted out some passing the eighth pole, reached the front in deep stretch then just missed. A PERFECT SQUEEZE raced just off the rail into the lane and finished willingly. FORTUNATE SLEW three wide on the backstretch and into the far turn, reached the front on the final bend, was well off the rail into the lane then yielded through the late stages. REGINA BEATRIZ bobbed at the start, raced off the rail into the clubhouse turn and vied for the lead, was between foes into the far turn, could not keep pace on the final turn and was five wide into the lane. CODE TWO hung five wide early, stayed outside and lacked a bid. SKIP AWAY BELLE hung four wide briefly early, was angled to the rail on the clubhouse turn, moved up and pressed the issue then was bumped in tight entering the far turn and dropped back. A claim of foul by the rider of SKIP AWAY BELLE against FORTUNATE SLEW for interference entering the far turn was not allowed.
