EXPECT THE BEST rated close off the rail, moved alongside the pacesetter through the turn, edged clear the upper stretch and held well under steady pressure. STRINGTOWN WONDER rated the pace inside, was pressured through the turn, dropped back giving chase in the upper stretch then yielded the final furlong. UNDISCLOSED rated just off the pace toward the outside, gave chase in the five path on the turn and finished evenly for show. HARDTOBETHEBEST exchanged bumps with Summer's Breeze at the start, showed no speed, bid saving ground on the turn, was eased out through the upper stretch and finished evenly. YES WE CAN showed no speed, was in the four path on the turn and empty in the stretch. FOREST GROVE chased the pace from the inside and gave way the last eighth. SUMMER'S BREEZE exchanged bumps with Hardtobethest at the start, steadied briefly then never factored. SENOR GATOR showed some very brief speed chasing the early pace then gave way.
