SUMMER STING moved up four wide on the turn and reached the front nearing the quarter pole then gradually edged clear. AWANDA saved ground on the turn and finished well for the place. PASSION'S DESTINY vied for the early lead, saved ground and weakened late. SISTER DISCO raced six wide turning for home and gained some late. OUT OF THE LOOP prompted the early issue, raced head and head for command on the turn while three deep and weakened in the drive. FIELDS OF GAIL raced five wide into the stretch, moved in and lacked the needed late response. TONI TATS was away slowly then dropped well back, advanced some into the turn and lacked solid stretch response. SALTA SAPO pressed the early issue between rivals and tired through the lane. CATACHIP came in leaving the gate bothering a rival, chased and tired. EIGHTOFUS was through early. DELICATE DUSTY was steadied when bothered leaving the gate then failed to menace.
