WYATT'S WOMEN stalked early outside, moved to the front passing the quarter pole, drew clear in the stretch then held to the wire. SWEET YAMILA raced between rivals entering the far turn, was three wide into the lane and finished gamely. LIGHT THE CANDLES moved up inside nearing the half mile pole, saved ground to the lane, eased off the inside and lacked the needed response. HIGHLAND LASS raced near the inside to the lane and lacked the needed rally. C. D. JEWEL set the early pace inside and weakened through the stretch. SUNDAYS ON THE BAY close up early, raced three wide and tired through the lane.
