BEST JAZZ bobbled at the break, raced close up early, moved up between rivals to contest the pace, dueled inside on the far turn and drew clear under urging. CHASING THE MONEY raced close up inside, made a bid on the rail at the top of the lane and was outfinished. EXTRAEXTRAORDINARY raced three wide early, chased four wide on the backside, continued three wide on the far turn and weakened late. HOLLYWOOD LOU had a ground saving trip and gained mildly inside. GRAND REALITY (ARG) hopped at the start, race off the rail, moved up between rivals on the backside and lacked a rally. PLUM CREEK vied two wide for the early lead, raced three wide on the backside, dueled between foes on the far turn and faded. STRAIGHT NO CHASER vied inside and gave way.
