CHECK POINT unhurried early while saving ground, eased out on the final turn while lodging a bid, raced four wide into the stretch and reached the pacesetter nearing the furlong marker then drove clear. DEBONAIR DARLING moved in while clear on the clubhouse turn, set the pace and held well while no match late to the top one. SUCCESSFUL SONG moved in entering the far turn, saved ground to the lane, eased off the rail in upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. AMAZING well placed early, raced three wide and between rivals turning for home and weakened in the drive. C C'S PAL tracked early, chased on the final turn and tired through the lane. SWEET GOODBYE in good position early while near the rail, lacked a response and weakened through the stretch.
