EVAMAR (BRZ), unhurriedly off the rail, bid angling five wide approaching the straightaway, dueled through the final furlong and edged clear the last seventy yards. SOUNDS FISHY rated close inside, eased out entering the stretch and made her bid, dueled through the final furlong but was outfinished the last seventy yards. COUNTESSA rated off the pace inside, bid in the four path on the final turn then finished evenly for show. LICENSE TO SPEED, unhurriedly, saved ground while lacking room on the final turn then made a mild inside stretch bid. FLAME SONG rated a clear pace off the rail, was under pressure from the top of the stretch but leveled out the final furlong. RAINBOW SMILE showed no speed in mid track, dropped back steadying on the final turn then proved empty in the stretch. BUY ON THE DIPS was outrun. ANOTHER EPISODE rated off the pace about the four path, saved some ground through the final turn then tired. CHATEAU BEACH (IRE) kept close with the early leaders in the three path, gave way rounding the final turn and not abused in the drive.
