FIRECARD rated just off the pace and off the rail, waited while in tight through the home turn, bid from the top of the stretch, reached the front approaching the seventy yard pole and was drawing off the final yards. CIGNO D'ORO rated in good position outside, advanced to a short lead in the middle of the final turn, moved clear entering the stretch but was outfinished the last seventy yards. EASTERN GALE raced unhurriedly while never far back, closed inside nearing the final turn, was boxed in through the turn, eased slightly out for the drive and finished evenly for show. ASSAGGINI, unhurried toward the outside, advanced widest on the final turn, made light contact with Out Of The Will entering the stretch and proved empty the remainder. OUT OF THE WILL rated off the pace about the four path, bid toward the outside on the final turn, made light contact with Assaggini entering the stretch and weakened from there. WILLIE'S LUV rated the pace toward the inside, contested the rail through the final turn then weakened. TERRIFIED ICE rated close off the rail, contested while between rivals on the final turn then weakened in the drive. THIRD COLLECTION, unhurried outside, was never a factor.
