Footnotes

RUSSIAN BAY rated close in the three path, started his drive four wide near the quarter pole, dueled to the lead midstretch and edged clear under steady handling. I'M ONLY LAUGHING rated off the pace toward the outside, bid five wide nearing the quarter pole, drifted in from the furlong pole and finished best for place. MY HUSBAND bobbled at the break, settled in off the rail, bid leaving the quarter pole, angled inside of Opera Box midstretch, altered course outside that one at the sixteenth pole and finished well when clear. OPERA BOX advanced to contention off the rail nearing the final turn, took aim at the quarter pole, briefly had the lead entering the stretch then weakened while wavering lanes a furlong out. MR. SNIPPINGTON was pinched back at the start, rated off the pace inside, gave chase into the turn then tired. SARATOGA JULES stumbled at the break, rated a clear early lead off the rail, was pressured from the quarter pole and weakened a furlong away. TRUE CALL chased the pace from off the rail and weakened on the final turn. TYLER REX was no factor.
