CAUSE I CAN prompted the early issue three deep, vied for the lead turning for home and finished steadily while edging clear. NICKY RED four deep into the turn, chased three wide on the bend and continued on willingly while no match late. HERCULON bumped at the start, raced along the inside on the turn and into the lane then gradually gained late. JAX MAXX raced between rivals into the lane, was in close in upper stretch then offered a late gain. LUCKY EVENING well placed inside, chased then weakened in the drive. JERSEY STORM CAT bumped at the start, moved up early and vied for the lead inside then tired in the drive. KING MAX raced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. PASTA LOVER stumbled at the start, raced three wide turning for home and came in some then weakened in the drive. KINGDA KA steadied early in close, raced outside and lacked a bid. ALCATRAZ pressed early, raced four wide into the lane and tired. HOTTENTOT SUNDAY fractious in the gate breaking through without the rider, broke inward then showed little.
