MORNING LINE came out some at the start, set the pace inside and responded to urging while drawing out through the final furlong. COMICAL in tight at the start then up close, lodged a bid nearing the top of the lane then was no match while holding the place. EMPIRIOR came out some at the start, saved ground into the far turn, eased out and finished willingly. STREET TALK'N MAN forced in at the start and near the rail into the far turn, lacked the needed rally. MARINE MAJOR broke inward, moved up outside rivals on the clubhouse turn and pressed the issue entering the backstretch, weakened on the final turn and raced five wide into the lane. ZEN VILLAGE stumbled at the start to be away slowly, moved up inside nearing the half mile pole then weakened on the final turn. RAPHAEL ALEXANDRO stumbled at the start and pinched back, raced in the three path leaving the backstretch and lacked a rally. RESCATOR in tight at the start, prompted early, raced four wide into the far turn and weakened.
