SUMMER COLONY broke in some then allowed to settle, moved outside on the backstretch, advanced three deep to challenge for the lead approaching the quarter pole, bumped lightly with a rival at the head of the stretch then finished steadily and was edging away late. SHE'S GOT THE BEAT under restraint early while along the inside, moved out after dropping back some on the final turn then finished well for the place. CALL AN AUDIBLE close up early from the outside, lodged a bid on the final turn and raced head and head for command while between foes, bumped lightly with a rival at the top of the lane then weakened through the late stages. ALCHEMILLA drew clear after the opening sixteenth and angled inside, was rated on the early pace, saved ground and responded when challenged in earnest then weakened in the drive.
