PRECIOUS MEM showed the early way inside, eased out after being displaced, raced four wide entering the lane and battled for command then proved best. ALARMING AFFAIR broke a bit slowly, advanced inside on the turn, was in tight along the rail into the stretch then continued on gamely. HORSIN' AROUND near the rail into the turn, raced in the four path entering the stretch and lacked a solid response. SMALL SECRET came out slightly at the start then up close, raced in tight between rivals turning for home and chased then was not good enough. TRUST N MADAM came in some at the start and steadied, moved up and drew clear passing the half mile pole, was three wide and between foes into the lane and tired. REALLY BULLISH forwardly placed early, lacked a response. AFLEET MEMORIES bumped and in tight at the start, lacked a bid.
