BIG IDE advanced inside on the turn, reached the front in upper stretch and drew clear then lasted over THE LADY IS RED. THE LADY IS RED was under a rating hold while awaiting room through upper stretch, advanced between foes leaving the furlong grounds then just missed. MS. MARYBETH challenged for the lead from the outside nearing the top of the lane then was not good enough. ELLIE'S QUEST posted the early fractions, raced just off the rail into the lane and weakened in the drive. PURE WILD between rivals into the turn, raced along the inside during the stretch run and lacked the needed response. GRAND PARTICULIER broke alertly, raced forwardly placed form the outside, lugged in some during the stretch run and tired. P. J.'S DAY a bit fractious in the post parade, broke out sharply and failed to menace. SEGRETO stumbled at the start then lacked a response.
