BOLD SURVIVOR chased inside, was steadied past the half mile marker and lacked a late rally. JOKERS WIN raced off the rail, wide at the quarter pole and had no rally. ULTIMATE raced inside, was steadied at the three eighths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. JOEY THE PRINCE was outrun. BALI BAY came five wide into the lane and flattened out. NEAT SOLUTION chased outside and faded.
