### Footnotes

TIZ A HOMERUN between rivals into the clubhouse turn and up close, moved to the front passing the quarter pole and drew well clear in the lane then held a rival safe nearing the wire. AN IMAGINARY ROAD saved ground into the far turn, eased out slightly while lodging a bid and finished gamely. REVENTON just off the inside turning for home, offered a late gain. ROSE BRIER was bumped entering the clubhouse turn while between rivals, chased three wide on the final turn and weakened in the drive. OKLAHOMA DEN had the saddle slip early, trailed then offered a stretch gain. OCEAN CITY set the early pace inside and tired in the drive. SO OUTSPOKEN five wide early, raced forwardly placed to the far turn, moved to the rail on the final bend and tired. IN THE BUILDING bumped and in tight into the clubhouse turn, chased to the far turn and weakened. TAX REFORM saved ground and lacked a bid. ROYAL HARD SPUN raced near the inside into the far turn and lacked a rally.
