Footnotes

CASSIDY'S CODE raced along the inside turning for home, was angled through traffic during the stretch run then drove clear late. PETITE FANTASY eased out for the drive and finished willingly. MERRY MOOD offered a mild late gain from the outside. GEORGIA'S PRINCESS advanced three deep on the turn, drew clear in the stretch then weakened in the drive. MISS RETAIL chased the early leader, was steadied while dropping back from between rivals on the turn then raced four wide into the lane. BRAVIOSA raced five wide turning for home and tired. CAVAMARIE posted the early fractions and tired. DEWDROPINN advanced along the inside into the turn, raced between foes nearing the top of the lane and tired through the stretch.
