BRANDONS BEACH saved ground, rallied outside of EDGE OF A SHADOW, took a short lead a sixteenth out and was all out to hold on. WEST ABE was pinched back at the break, saved ground off the pace, rallied on the rail and just missed. EDGE OF A SHADOW dueled inside, shook clear and stayed on gamely to the end. SHORT TRIP had a three wide trip, made a mild bid and weakened. MAY EIGHTEENTH was outrun early and passed tired rivals. JAMESTOWN CAPTAIN did not factor. TUSCAN PRINCE dueled outside and tired. ALARMING GLORY chased and stopped.
