SUCCESSFUL SONG prompted the early issue and raced between rivals into the backstretch, saved ground entering the far turn, stayed inside and took command nearing the top of the lane then drew clear under urging. CASCABELLA moved to the front three deep on the backstretch, drew clear and raced just off the inside to the lane then continued on willingly while second best. DARING REALITY raced near the inside to the lane then earned the show award between rivals. IMA JERSEY GIRL away awkwardly, moved out while lodging a bid on the final turn, was in the three path into the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. LITTLE STITCH set the early pace, saved ground and remained a factor into the lane then weakened. SAVVY SUPREME saved ground early, raced three wide into the far turn and lacked the needed bid. BAHIA BEACH raced off the inside and lacked a rally. NORTH FREEWAY well placed early and between rivals leaving the backstretch, chased on the final turn e then was eased in the lane and vanned off.
