ADMIRAL PERRY tracked inside, waited for room passing the quarter pole, came through on the rail and quickly kicked away. FREUD'S HONOUR set the pace on the inside, came off the rail turning for home and was all out to save the place. MISTER PIPPIT pulled early along the inside, settled off the pace, rallied on the rail and just missed for second. MIKOSHI raced between foes, came five wide into the lane and failed to threaten. HOUNGUN raced three wide, swung six wide entering the stretch and needed more. AGONISTIC pressed the pace, made a bid and weakened late. PLAY IT STRAIGHT stalked outside, bid three wide on the far turn and weakened.
