HORATIA (IRE) between rivals into the far turn, advanced into the lane and responded gamely to prevail. CAMELLA raced between foes leaving the backstretch, was three deep into the lane and closed well late. CHAMPAGNE ROYAL dueled inside early, eased out on the backstretch, drew clear during the stretch run then continued on gamely. MELODY QUEEN (GB) raced in traffic entering the far turn then was going well at the end. ENTER drew clear between calls on the backstretch, saved ground thereafter and weakened in the drive. DOCTRESSA lacked the needed response. GIMMEAKISSEE raced well placed until nearing the lane and weakened. ELLAKAPELLA (NZ) saved ground while forwardly placed then tired through the lane. LUMINOUS PRIZE well placed into the far turn, tired. JEUNESSE DOREE lacked a bid. RED ROYAL lacked a rally.
