TAP DAY saved ground while vying for the early lead then responded well and drew clear through the stretch run. BRUCKER'S BROTHER battled for the lead outside the top one and was no match in the drive while second best. OUAGADOUGOU well placed while saving ground, lacked the needed stretch response. GOVERNOR BENNETT in close entering the clubhouse turn, lodged a bid outside on the final bend and weakened through the lane. SOY DESATANUDOS (ARG) saved ground and lacked a rally. ROAR ON TOUR broke a bit slowly and outside foes into the first turn, stayed outside and had little left entering the lane. WESTON FIELD in tight entering the first turn, raced just off the rail on the final turn and lacked a bid. SACSASAHUAMAN (CHI) came in some leaving the gate, gave way after a half and faded through the stretch.
