PROP ME UP saved ground turning for home, eased off the inside nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear late while being hand ridden. ALL DOLLED UP tracked the early leader, challenged for command on the final turn, reached the front and continued on willingly. JENNY BEAN GIRL well placed early, saved ground into the lane, eased off slightly and finished willingly. OUR JOY set the early pace, saved ground and weakened late. LOVING THOUGHTS saved ground into the far turn, eased off the inside and raced between foes passing the quarter pole then lacked the needed stretch response. SKIP'S SINGER lacked a rally. CAMP ON WOOD well placed early, lacked the needed response then tired in the drive. JOYFUL JACKIE fractious in the paddock area, dropped back early and lost contact.
