**Footnotes**

PEACE PLEDGE rated close about the three path, angled out entering the stretch, drew clear leaving the eighth pole then held on with a steady drive. SPIRITUAL AIR (GB) was shuffled back early, settled into stride just off the rail, advanced toward the front approaching the final turn, lacked room through the turn, bid on the rail entering the stretch, closed angling slightly out late and finished well. CUPID'S ARROW rated off the pace and off the rail, angled to the outside in the upper stretch, finished well while very wide. TEN KISSES was a step slow on the break, raced unhurriedly off the rail, rallied in mid track on the final turn, angled out in the upper stretch, closed well then leveled off. MOOREBELLA raced unhurriedly toward the outside while never far back and finished evenly. MECKE'S PRINCESS rated off the pace toward the outside and was empty in the stretch. ROYAL DOVE rated close about the four path, rallied to a short lead nearing the quarter pole, dropped back an eighth out then gave way. MORNING SKY tired after half. NOTIMETOQUIT rated with the pace inside, contested the rail on the final turn then faded. LIVE DOPPLER rated the pace just off the rail, contested between rivals on the final turn then gave way.
