THUNDERING SUCCESS bobbled slightly leaving the gate, prompted the early issue, raced between rivals nearing the quarter pole, continued to press then responded gamely to prevail while being brushed nearing the wire. CALL MY BLUFF posted the early fractions, raced off the rail into the lane, dug in gamely, came out some nearing the wire brushing a rival then just failed. MURDERINTHEFIRST well placed while saving ground, eased off the inside late and finished willingly. WILENTZ bumped lightly at the start and between rivals early, raced just off the inside and lacked the needed response then tired in the drive. GRANDSTANDING well placed early from the outside, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, weakened in midstretch and was pulled up nearing the wire then walked off. SEPTEMBER HERO trailed early while not far back and lacked a rally .
