SIR TYLER T saved ground, waited for room on the turn, came through on the rail turning for home and drew clear, driving. AWESOME CHARLIE stalked three wide, came four wide into the lane and dug in gamely to earn the place. A BIT OF MADNESS was sent early, vied outside and stayed on well to the end. UNTOPABLE vied inside and weakened. EDGEMOOR raced off the pace, moved up outside a rival on the turn and failed to sustain a bid. SMOOTH WIND was outrun early, raced off the rail, came wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SNOW COUNTRY was outrun early and gained some ground in the stretch. INDIAN RESERVATION raced four wide into the first turn, chased and tired. ARROW'S FLIGHT raced off the pace, swung wide turning for home, gave way and was vanned off. NIGHT CHAPEL saved ground and did not factor. INCREDIBLE SPEED raced four wide into the first turn, chased four wide and faded.
