HUNTERS BAY set the pace inside then responded to urging and edged away through the final furlong. DUELING ALEX up close early and between rivals, raced along the inside on the final turn and finished gamely for the place. CACTUS CHARLIE moved up outside in the run down the backstretch, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, chased and needed more in the drive. HARMONIZER never far back while three wide, lacked the needed stretch response. NUMB LIPS bumped at the start and shuffled back, raced outside into the far turn, was four wide into the lane and lacked the needed rally. FOUR SHORE saved ground to the far turn, raced four wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. TEAKS NORTH broke in and bumped, prompted the issue, chased and tired in the drive. CHARLES RUSSELL up close early inside, lacked a response. ANTITRUST was rank and steadied on the backstretch then lacked a rally.
