MY JEFF'S MOMBO tracked the leaders three wide early, made a bid three wide while engaging the leaders on the final turn, was four wide into the stretch and edged clear in the final furlong. LOADED GUN chased along the rail early, made a bid for the lead while on the rail on the final turn, split rivals in upper stretch and finished with a flurry. BRUSHED ON set the pace early and gave way in the later stages of the race. POWER BY FAR chased two wide early, was four wide entering the stretch, found his best stride and finished with good energy. WIRE ME COLLECT chased five wide early, made a bid for the lead three wide on the final turn, loomed boldly six wide into the stretch and ran even in the remaining balance of the contest. ORO DE MEXICO was in close attendance early while two wide, made a bid for the lead two wide on the final turn, had every chance to pass the leaders in the stretch and tired late. MASTER O FOXHOUNDS hustled early to get into the contest, bore out badly on the final turn and failed to recover. WHY CHANGE was no factor. .
