BIG BAMBU posted the early fractions, raced off the rail into the lane, widened some into midstretch then maintained a safe margin to the wire. KATZ ME IF YOU CAN broke alertly and always a factor from the outside, lodged a bid on the turn and was second best. SUPERDUPER MISS saved ground and lacked the needed late response. LILY'S AFFAIR trailed to the lane then offered a mild late gain outside. LUCKY LIVI lodged a bid outside on the turn then offered little in the drive. CEDAR KNOLLS chased early, remained a factor into the lane and weakened. TO MARQUET lacked a response. ELEVEN NORTH raced forwardly placed into the turn, dropped back then gradually gave way.
