Footnotes

AVIATE'EM firmly rated the pace on the inside, was asked from the top of the stretch and responded well to maintain her lead. LA CAT rated close to the pace from the inside, saved ground through the final turn, was eased off the rail in the upper stretch and gave chase the remainder. RIOTOUS MISS raced close to the pace from the rail, lost momentum briefly when boxed in entering the final turn, was eased out leaving the turn and closed to late stretch, finishing well. SPICY GIRL was unhurried down the backstretch, made her bid circling horses on the final turn and had some mild outside late gain. MARQ OF BEAUTY stalked the lead just outside the pacesetter then weakened in the three path through the stretch. INN BETWEEN rated close to the pace from the outside, was six wide entering the stretch and finished evenly. TALKIN TO AN ANGEL ran out into the opening turn, raced unhurriedly off the rail on the backstretch and was never a factor.
