**Footnotes**

MEADOW BLUE broke inward making solid contact with Stone Kiss, waited off the pace in mid track, started his drive approaching the final turn, was driven clear toward the quarter pole then widened while relaxing the last furlong. STONE KISS was jostled soundly at the break, rated off the pace in mid track, bid into the final turn, proved no match for the winner but lasted for place. IDOL GINA, unhurried, bid off the rail on the final turn and finished evenly for show. ROCK THE RAINBOW rated off the pace inside, steadied on the rail leaving the quarter pole then recovered well enough to finish evenly. EVENING PALS, unhurried off the rail, angled out making his bid on the final turn then leveled off through the lane. FAGEDABOUDIT SAL was outrun in mid track. DROPKICK MURPHY was rushed to a clear early lead in position just off the rail, maintained the advantage to the final turn then faded through the stretch. MAKE MIKE'S DAY broke outward bumping Stone Kiss and outrun afterward. RUNAWAY TRAIN never factored. SKIP ALONG JET kept close to the early pace about the three path, gave chase toward the final turn then weakened drifting outward through the turn.
