EXPLOIT'S KID just off the early leaders, lodged a bid between rivals nearing the top of the lane, reached the front in the stretch and drew clear then held a rival safe nearing the wire. CORREDOR'S SONG well placed while saving ground, eased out some for the drive and finished gamely. ROMAN TIGER broke in some and in a bit close to be away a bit awkwardly, trailed and moved four wide for the drive then closed well late. KING CARTER lodged a bid outside on the final turn, raced four wide into the stretch, moved in and lacked the needed closing response. TALE OF VICTORY set the pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. OUR ROYAL AFFAIR saved ground and lacked the needed bid. GO TEBOW GO broke in some and bumped at the start, prompted the issue and tired through the lane. SOLDIER SAM raced three wide down the backstretch while forwardly placed and lacked the needed bid. FUPEG RIVER raced three wide turning for home and offered little in the drive. GREAT MAGIC broke out and bumped, saved ground and lacked a response.
